In accordance with Section 37E of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended), Cush Wind Limited gives notice of its intention to make an application to An Bord Pleanála for a ten-year permission in relation to a proposed development in the townlands of Cush, Galros West, Boolinarig Big, Eglish, and Ballindown, County Offaly; as follows:-

- 8 no. wind turbines with hub height of 114 metres, a rotor diameter of 172 metres and an overall tip height of 200 metres;
- ii. All associated turbine foundations and crane hardstanding areas;iii. A wind farm control building with a gross floor area of 131 square metres;
- iv. Underground electrical and commu
